

## TECHNICAL ANALYST DUTIES

<b>POSITION:</b>	Technical Analyst of the New Zealand Maori Team ("the team")
<b>REPORTING TO:</b>	New Zealand Maori Team Manager
<b>PURPOSE:</b>	To ensure that the NZ Maori Team are a successful, winning team.

The Technical Analyst will:

1. video record matches and/or trainings as required and directed by the team Coach;
2. operate Verusco TryMaker Pro and/or TryMaker+, including downloading and coding the recorded matches and/or trainings into the Verusco TryMaker Pro and/or TryMaker+ system for the matches and/or trainings to be viewed and analysed;
3. analyse matches and trainings recorded using Verusco TryMaker Pro and/or TryMaker+ as required by the team Coach;
4. provide analysis information, including statistical data, on the performance of players to the team Coach as required;
5. provide opposition analysis of strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats, with recommendations on strategies to prepare for the opposition based on that analysis, to the team Coach as required;
6. provide general IT support to other members of Team management, including performing any necessary maintenance tasks and producing any audio-visual material as required.
7. Supply copies of games and statistical analysis to the High Performance Department of the NZRU.
8. Develop individualised CD ROM's of players' strengths and weaknesses for the players and to send back to unions, working closely with the Coach.
9. Video and download training sessions for players to analyse performance.
10. At development camps and trials co ordinate video footage and coding of matches for resource coaches and the NZRU.
